Prayer requires Faith



Faith

- confidence or trust in a person or thing: faith in another's ability.
- belief that is not based on proof: He had faith that the hypothesis would be substantiated by fact.
- the obligation of loyalty or fidelity to a person, promise, engagement, etc.: Failure would be breaking faith.
- Christian Theology. The trust in God and in His promises as made through Christ and the Scriptures by which humans are justified or saved.
